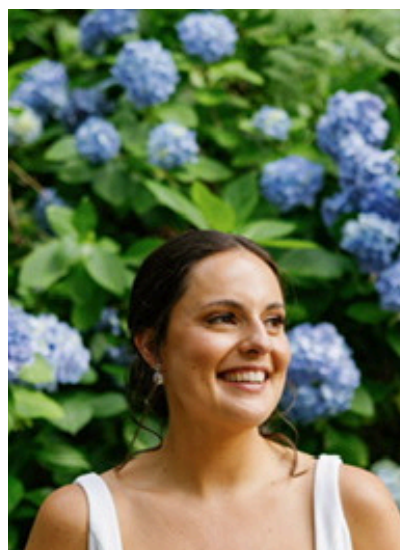


MEET YOUR ART TEACHER
